



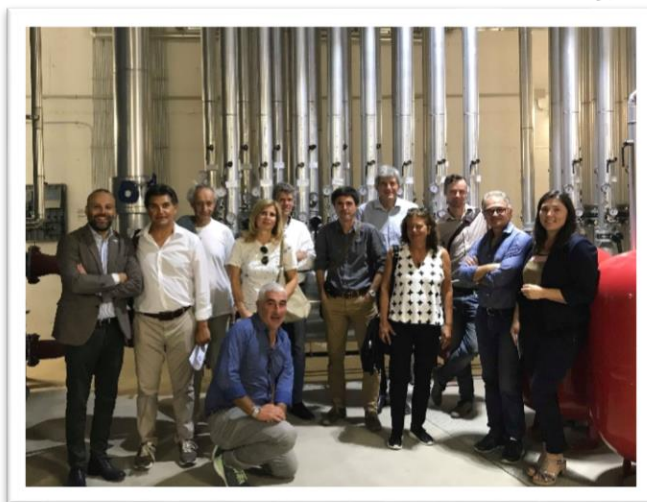
JPGE Meetings Rome

EERA JPGE organized meetings 24-25 September 2018, hosted by ENEA in Rome. There were 36 participants attending and all Sub Programmes were present, of the participating member institutions 23 was represented and 3 potential new members joined the meetings.

The first day started with lunch followed by a warm welcome by Marina Leonardi, Head of International Relations Office, Relations and Communication Unit, introducing JPGE to ENEA and its history. The rest of the day was dedicated to the JPGE Sub programmes, their activities and the Description of Work (DoW). The Sub programme coordinators and the Management Board had jointly prepared a draft of the DoW that was presented and discussed.

Break-out sessions for each Sub Programme

Members were divided into groups based on the respective Sub programmes to discuss the proposed changes to the DoW in more detail. The aim was also to plan future workshops and update the scientific activities. This was followed by a plenum session where the outcome was summarized and presented by the Sub Programme Coordinators.



JPGE Steering Committee meeting was held the second day. Several important resolutions were made, amongst them the approval of 3 new Associate participants: *Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne*, *University of Geneva* and *Università degli studi di Firenze*.

Some of the JPGE participants also attended an organized field site visit to a Geothermal site organized at the end of second day.
